Transport

Remember you are heading to the University of Bath NOT Bath Spa University. Also the train station is called Bath Spa, not just Bath.

BA2 7PD

The correct postcode to use with Satellite Navigation machines to reach the University of Bath is BA2 7PD.

No Shuttle Bus

Unfortunately due the wide spread of arrival times it has not been feasible to arrange a free shuttle bus from the train and bus station to the University. The local bus service is very easy to use, simply cross the road outside train stations and catch U1, U2 or U18 to the University of Bath. It is a 10 min journey and costs £1.50 per person.
