

PRIZE DRAW STANDARD TERMS AND CONDITIONS

1 THE PROMOTER

- 1.1 The promoter is The Institution of Engineering and Technology of Michael Faraday House, Six Hills Way, Stevenage, Herts., SG1 2AY, United Kingdom (the "**Promoter**")

2 THE PRIZE DRAW

- 2.1 The title of the prize draw is YWE Guest Box

3 HOW TO ENTER

- 3.1 Internet access is required.
- 3.2 The prize draw will run from 2.00pm GMT on 3 December 2020 (the "**Opening Date**") to 11.59pm (GMT) on 31 January 2021 (the "**Closing Date**") inclusive.
- 3.3 To enter the prize draw, entrants must register to attend The IET Young Women Engineer of the Year (virtual ceremony) at [<https://youngwomenengineer.theiet.org/>], and tick to "opt in" to the prize draw, before the Closing Date. Entrants must include their name, email address, address (including postcode) and telephone number as part of the registration process.

4 ELIGIBILITY
